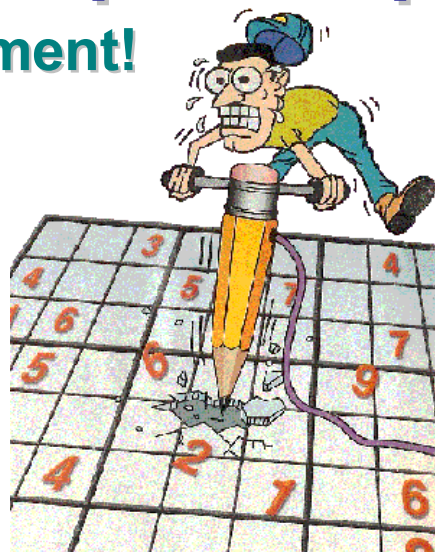

HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP

- ▶ The 2nd Malaysia Sudoku Championship is open to all citizens of Malaysia irrespective of age. All are welcome.
- ▶ Entrance Fee **per person per category** is **RM10.00 (TEN Ringgit)** payable before or on the day of competition.
- ▶ Participants are welcome to walk in, register and take part on the day of competition. Please come **ONE HOUR** before the start of each category. Walk-in participants will be registered on a First-Come-First-Served basis. Priority will be given to participants with reserved or guaranteed places.
- ▶ If you wish to reserve a place, please pre-register by emailing your **Full Name, IC No., Mobile No. and Championship Category** to mysudokusociety@gmail.com, or by faxing these information plus your email address to **03-7725 1492** using the form on the reverse side of this brochure. Pre-payment of the Entrance Fee is encouraged to simplify registration process on the day of competition.

CHAMPIONSHIP CATEGORIES

- ▶ **Student Category**
For those born in 1993 or after.
- ▶ **Senior Citizen Category**
For those born in 1956 or before.
- ▶ **Open Category**
Open to everyone irrespective of age.
- ▶ **1Sudoku^(a) Category**
Open to everyone irrespective of age.
All finalists^(b) from the earlier 3 categories will also be invited to take part.

Note (a) '1Sudoku' is a Sudoku variant also known as 'Sum Sudoku', but with only one clue in the center.

Note (b) If you emerge as a finalist and you have already paid to take part in the 1Sudoku Category, the money will be refunded to you.

CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

- ▶ A participant can take part in more than one category provided he/she meets the criterion.
- ▶ The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to any aspect of the Championship, including prizes and schedule, if circumstances beyond its control necessitate such action(s).

Malaysia Sudoku Championship

RULES & REGULATIONS

To all Competitors at the Championship:

1. By taking part in the Malaysia Sudoku Championship, you are deemed to have accepted the rules and regulations set forth by the Organizer, as follows.
2. You are allowed to bring your own writing equipment and erasers for the purpose of answering the competition puzzles. You may request the same from the Organizer if you do not possess any.
3. You are NOT allowed to have any paper, books or personal effects on your table throughout the duration of the competition round (Preliminary Round and Final Round). All personal effects are to be kept away from the table, and may be kept beside where you sit.
4. All electronic and mobile devices are to be switched off and stored in your bag. You are NOT allowed to retrieve anything from your bag throughout the duration of the competition round, unless you are granted permission by the Organizer.
5. You are NOT allowed to photograph, record or copy the competition puzzle(s). Any attempt to do so will lead to immediate disqualification.
6. At the beginning of each competition round, you are to open the question paper and to start solving AFTER being instructed by the Organizer. Any attempt to start solving earlier than instructed will lead to immediate disqualification.
7. Throughout the duration of the competition round, you are NOT allowed to talk to other competitors or spectators. You are also NOT allowed to look at other competitors' answers.
8. Except for the 1Sudoku Category, each Preliminary Round consists of TWO classic 9x9 Sudoku puzzles. The Final Round consists of THREE classic 9x9 Sudoku puzzles. For the 1Sudoku Category, each Preliminary Round consists of ONE 9x9 1Sudoku puzzle. The Final Round also consists of ONE 9x9 1Sudoku puzzle
9. At the end of each competition round, you must surrender the question paper to the Organizer without exception. You are NOT allowed to take away the question paper.
10. During each competition round, If and when you have finished solving the competition puzzle(s), raise your hand and an invigilator will come and collect your question paper. Please remain seated throughout the duration of the competition round.
11. For each Preliminary Round, the competition ends after the first 10 competitors have finished or after 10 minutes, whichever is earlier. For the Final Round, the competition ends after all 10 competitors have finished or after 30 minutes, whichever is earlier. This applies to all four categories.
12. Throughout the competition, speed is the criterion used by the Judges to decide the qualifiers / winners. There may be additional prizes that are awarded based on age, etc.
13. A competitor may take part in more than one category if he/she is eligible. But no competitor shall win more than one of the twelve main prizes (1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes x 4 categories).
14. The decisions of the panel of judges are final and CANNOT be disputed or challenged at all times throughout and after the competition.
15. The Organizer will NOT be held responsible in the unlikely event that a prize winner encounters difficulty in respect of the prizes. This includes product quality or quality of service on the part of the sponsors.
